

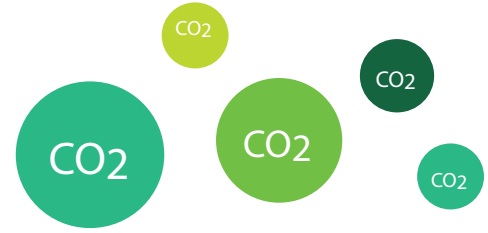
Wurster: The Road to Zero Waste

This equates to an annual savings of \$1,404 for the University. Money that goes into funding sustainability initiatives, green student jobs, and further waste diversion activities.



This equates to an annual reduction of 1,576.8 kilograms of green house gasses from entering our atmosphere. Permanently. Every year.
